Purpose of Short-Term Mission Trips

The college ministry at Calvary Church values missions. We continue in Calvary's history of training up young people for the work of missions. If you are not aware of Calvary's history, we encourage you to read up on it. Many missions organizations were born here at Calvary and hundreds of missionaries have called Calvary their home church. Short Term Missions serves as a training ground for young people. It is the primary place for a teenager to be exposed to what the international mission field looks like.

We do this by bringing students to the front lines of international missions work. These students come alongside our missionaries or missions partners to help them continue the work that they have started. They support the missionaries and begin to make bonds with local people in the countries that we visit. Through these trips many things start to develop in the heart of a young person: a love for the people of every nation, a bigger picture of the world is drawn, and in many cases God uses this to draw students out of their comfort zones to serve Him more radically.

Young people also grow in their understanding of themselves. Traveling internationally sheds light on who we are. When we step outside of our normal context we can often make sense of our life like never before. We can think of nothing better for a college student than to see themselves in light of the vastness of the world and the breadth of God's love for every human on earth.

Lastly, these Short Term Mission trips are a response to the call that God has given us. The College Ministry is going to Lesvos, Greece to work with refugees. God has called us to live a life of loving others and this summer we have an opportunity to respond to the call of the Lord, to grow as people, and to develop into mature Christians with a heart for international missions.

WHO CAN GO ON THIS TRIP?

This trip is for anyone in the Calvary Church College Ministry. Everyone on the trip must be 18 years of age or older by August 6th, 2019. There are no special skills that are necessary, just a loving heart and a willingness to serve.

WHERE IS THETRIP?

Lesvos, Greece.

Lesvos is a Greek island in the northern Aegean Sea off the coast of Turkey. Millions of people are fleeing their home countries due to the tyranny of war, famine, and heartache and ending up on the islands of Greece.



WHAT WILL WE BE DOING?

As previously mentioned, millions of people are fleeing their home countries due to dangerous situations such as war and famine. In fact, this is the largest movement of people in modern history since the Second World War. Greece and Europe are still getting around 1,000 new arrivals every month who wash up on the shores to start a new life.

For most, Europe offers the only hope of safety, and many risk the very real threat of death on their journeys. Often, these people are seen as a problem, and while our enemy can use people to kill, steal, and destroy, God sees each and every person as a unique and loved creation. These are our neighbors, and we want to introduce each and every refugee to the God who loves them.

EuroRelief is looking for teams of adults to come and serve in Greece. The situation in the camp where we will serve is constantly changing, thus our roles are constantly changing. Currently, EuroRelief assists with housing, distributing clothing and hygiene kits to new refugee arrivals, and guarding/assisting the most vulnerable of those housed in the camp. We will also have the opportunity to hear their stories and share God's love and His story with them. Truly, our team will get a chance to practice Matthew 25:40 "the least of these" in a very real way.

SAFETY & TRAVEL

We understand that traveling around the world and ministering to people in far away countries presents a danger that is not encountered in the everyday life of a college student. Both the college ministry and Calvary Church realize that there is an inherent risk in traveling outside the country and being in these places. However, we do not view the risk as a serious crisis. To promote your safety while on these trips we diligently take proactive steps in protecting everyone involved with Short Term Missions. We try our best to take major airlines that have great safety ratings. We never leave the groups alone in dangerous circumstances. When groups are on their own it is only in safe places where police presence is available and reliable. We also do our homework by looking into current situations that are happening in the countries we travel to. We check in with all local US Embassies before our arrivals. Additionally, we always have responsible, well-traveled leaders who are leading these trips. In partnering with GEM (Greater Europe Mission), we always have them looking out for us and our safety.

We do all of this to minimize any potential danger that can come up. In all the years that we have been doing these trips we have been very successful in eliminating the danger of traveling while staying in these foreign countries. That being said, God has called us to reach out to the whole world, and at Calvary Church we follow in the footsteps of those who have gone before us and boldly go out to wherever the Lord calls us. Please contact us with any concerns you may have in this area.

WHAT IS THE COST?

Somewhere between \$2,700-\$3,000 with a \$150 deposit included in the overall cost. Due to uncertain travel costs & budget we cannot give you the exact amount at this time. However, in a few short weeks we will have a final cost for you.

FUNDRAISING

Each team member is responsible for the total cost of his or her trip and we understand this cost is very expensive. However, the entirety of this trip is paid for fully through fundraising (except for the deposit). We require that each team member send out support letters to family and friends to raise financial support. We will teach each team member how to support raise. If for some reason a team member does not raise enough funds to fully pay his or her balance, then he/she is responsible for paying the rest of the balance on their own. If you have any questions about the cost of the trip please do not hesitate to ask Eryn.

TRIP DEBRIEF:

On our way back home from Greece we will spend two nights in Athens. The purpose of this layover is to debrief from our experience in Lesvos. We will have group time as well as solo time journaling and praying to aid in processing the trip as a whole. Along with this we will have the opportunity to explore some ancient sites and be in places of early church history.





Dear Foundation Students,

It is my sincere prayer that God will guide you as you prayerfully consider this opportunity to serve the Lord and the refugee people in Lesovos, Greece. Mission trips are a large part of Calvary Church and I believe that they are valuable ways for each of us to live out our faith, help meet the needs of others, share the gospel of Jesus Christ, experience change, and grow closer to God. Additionally, the team will have to consist of individuals who are capable of being responsible for their personal belongings and respectful to the other team members and people we encounter along the way. In the event the trip funds I raise exceed my budget, I understand that any excess funds will be applied to other's accounts going on this Calvary Global Short Term Missions Trip. Calvary Church of Santa Ana STATEMENT OF DOCTRINE

- 1. We believe the sixty-six books of the Bible, consisting of all the books of the Old and New Testaments, are the written Word of God. They are a supernatural revelation from God Himself. These books are inspired, inerrant and infallible, without error of any kind in every word and concept. They are the final authority on all matters they address, and all truth necessary for our salvation and spiritual life.(Psalm 19:7·11; John 14:26; John 16:12·-15; I Corinthians 2:12·-16; II Timothy 3:16·-17; II Peter 1:16·-21; I John 2:27)
- 2. We believe in the Trinity. There is only one God and in the Trinity there are three eternal and coequal persons: God the Father; God the Son (Jesus Christ; and God the Holy Spirit. (Deuteronomy 6:4; Isaiah 46:9; Matthew 3:16--17; Matthew 28:19; Il Corinthians 13:14; I John 5:1·8)
- 3. We believe Jesus Christ is one Person with two complete natures, divine and human. He is true God and true man. Jesus is God incarnate, being born of a virgin and is completely sinless. He eternally exists as the Logos, God the Son, the second person of the Trinity. Jesus has all the attributes, characteristics, and works of God. And as such, He should be worshiped as God by men and angels. (Isaiah 7:14; John 1:1--14; John 10:30--33; Colossians 1:16--19; Colossians 2:9)
- 4. We believe that all people are born with a sin nature and commit sins by falling short of God's holiness and violating His commands. (Romans 3:23; Romans 6:23; I John 3:4
- 5. We believe that Jesus Christ died for all people, offering His life as a substitute to atone for all sins. The salvation of any person is the work of God alone, by faith alone in Christ. All people who trust in Him as their only means of forgiveness for their sins will inherit eternal life with God. (John 3:1--18; John 6:44--69; John 14:1-6; John 17:3; Hebrews 2:9; Titus 3:4-7)
- 6. We believe in the physical resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ and that He ascended bodily into heaven. He is now at the right hand of God as mediator, priest, and advocate for each believer. (John 20; Acts 1:9-11; Acts 3:12-26; Corinthians 15:12-28; Hebrews 7:25; Hebrews 9:24)
- 7. We believe that Heaven is a real place of eternal blessedness in the presence of God and that Hell is a real place of eternal suffering and separation from God. (Matthew 25:46; Il Corinthians 5:1-10; Revelation 20; Revelation 21; Revelation 22)
- 8. We believe the Holy Spirit indwells every Christian and spiritually baptizes them, placing them into the body of Christ, His church, when they are saved. There is only one baptism but many fillings. Christians are commanded to be filled with the Holy Spirit for power to live a holy and obedient life for Jesus Christ. (Acts 2:38; Acts 13:52; Romans 8:14--27; Galatians 5:22--25; Ephesians 5:18)
- 9. We believe in the Great Commission in our own community and around the world. Jesus commands all believers to go evangelize and make disciples of all nations. We are to baptize and teach believer all that Jesus commands in His Word. (Matthew 28:19-·20; Luke 24:47; Acts 1:8; Il Timothy 3:16-·17)
- 10. We believe that all followers of the Lord Jesus are created in Him to glorify God by living holy lives and serving others in love with good works. These good works are evidence of a believer's salvation and not a means to gain salvation or favor with God. (I Corinthians 13; Ephesians 2:8-·10; Ephesians 4:1--32; Titus 2:1-5, 14; Titus 3:1--11; James 2:17)
- 11. We believe Satan and his demons are real, personal beings who are fallen angels in opposition to Jesus Christ and His church. (Isaiah 14:12--17; Matthew 4:2--11; John 8:44; Revelation 12:9--10)
- 12. We believe in the personal, premillennial second coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. He will come for His saints and then rule with them for a thousand years on this earth. He will then establish a new heaven and new earth for all believers to live eternally in the glory of God. (I Corinthians 15:50--55; I Thessalonians 4:13--18; Revelation 19:19--20; Revelation 20; Revelation 21; Revelation 22)
- 13. We believe that biblical marriage consists only of the union of one biological man and one biological woman, and that biblical marriage is the only legitimate and acceptable context for a sexual relationship. (Genesis 2:24; Romans 1:26--27).
