Four Phases of Discipleship by Jesus (pg. 16-18)

Come and See John 1:38-39

John 1:38-39

"And Jesus turned and saw them following, and said to them, 'What do you seek?' They said to Him, 'Rabbi (which translated means Teacher), where are You staying?'

John 1:38-39

He said to them, 'Come, and you will see.' So they came and saw where he was staying..."

Jesus exposed them to the nature of his ministry in John 1:35 - 4:46

Jesus' goal was to cause people to see through different eyes, a kingdom lens.



Come and Follow Me Mark 1:16-20

Mark 1:17-18

"And Jesus said to them, 'Follow Me, and I will make you become fishers of men.' Immediately they left their nets and followed Him."

Jesus was demonstrating interest to train them to follow him.

Jesus' model was to show them how to do it and then do it with them.

Discipleship along the way





Come and Be with Me (in the work of ministry) Matthew 9:37-38; 10:1, 5

Matthew 9:37-10:1, 5

"Then He said to His disciples, 'The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few. Therefore beseech the Lord of the harvest to send out workers into His harvest.

Matthew 9:37-10:1, 5

Jesus summoned His twelve disciples and gave them authority...These twelve Jesus sent out after instructing them..."

During this time, Jesus gave them special responsibility and authority.

He planned to pass his work on to them, prepared them for their new responsibility and sent them out in twos while demonstrating, explaining, experimenting and clarifying what was on his heart.

Jesus' model was to let them do ministry and then deploy them into their own ministry.



Remain in Me John 14:16; 15:7-8; 16:5-7

John 13 – 17 records Jesus' last days and final instructions before he releases his disciples to minister.

John 14:16 "I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may be with you forever."

John 15:7-8 "If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you. My Father is glorified by this, that you bear much fruit, and so prove to be my disciples."

John 16:5-7

"But now I am going to Him who sent Me...But I tell you the truth, it is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if I go, I will send Him to you."

The commission does not signify the end of a relationship but a change in the relationship, for the Holy Spirit would now lead them. (John 14)
